Collecting 500 healthy breast tissue samples from women

The Susan G. Komen Tissue Bank at the IU Simon Comprehensive Cancer Center (KTB) is a biorepository that collects breast tissue from healthy donors. These samples are then provided to breast cancer researchers for use as controls in scientific studies. As a part of the statewide Community Engagement Committee of the WNBA All-Star Game Indianapolis Host Committee, the KTB has been selected as one of 15 legacy projects. This will take the form of a large tissue collection event on the IU – Indianapolis campus on the weekend of July 12-13 (one week before the actual All-Star Game). With the help of **800+volunteers**, **500 women** will make an appointment to donate their breast tissue.
